RED CROSS DRIVERS NEEDED

The RED CROSS needs YOUR help. I have been driving blood from their contribution sites since 1993. What is needed is more drivers. In the past few months we have lost 3 drivers, with only 3 remaining. It takes about 2 ½ hours out of your day. With a Red Cross vehicle or your own (which I do), you have the blood in refrigerated boxes put into the vehicle and then you drive it to the Musser Center, the block surrounded by Callowhill and Spring Garden Sts. and 7th & 8th Sts., Phila. There are many ways to get there which I would show you. You can get reimbursed for your driving, but I take mine as a tax deduction each year. Gail Parker is our driver coordinator for the North Penn area, who calls monthly to help assign the days you are willing to work.
